We will also need a **medical and health enrollment form** for every child attending camp. Registered students may use the form from the school year providing it is current. New students or those with expired forms will need to submit/update a current form before they attend camp. Forms are available in the school office and online at www.colonialschools.org

Stuff to know:

Camps are filled on a first come first served basis and space is limited.

Minimum participation for each camp is 5 children. A full refund will be given if a camp is cancelled due to less than minimum participation.

Refunds will not be given for cancelled or missed days of camp.

If your child has any special needs or medical issues, you will be asked to provide a medical care plan. This plan will instruct staff how to respond to a medical emergency should one arise.

Camps including water activities will require a swim permission slip and life vests.

Camps including field trips will require a transportation permission slip.

All camps will be held at the Westover Preparatory School. Children will be outdoors during some camps.

Please apply sunscreen to your child and dress him/her for outdoor activities.

Lesson plans and activities are subject to change.

A snack will be provided during camp as part of the fun!
